This industrial USB 2.0 Hub offers a simple way to expand a system's current USB capability by providing 4 or 7 additional external USB 2.0 ports via a single USB 2.0 host connection. Fully compliant with USB 2.0 specifications, this hub is backward compatible with 1.x specifications to support older USB peripherals.

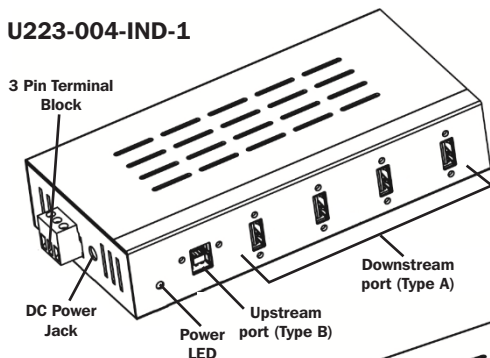

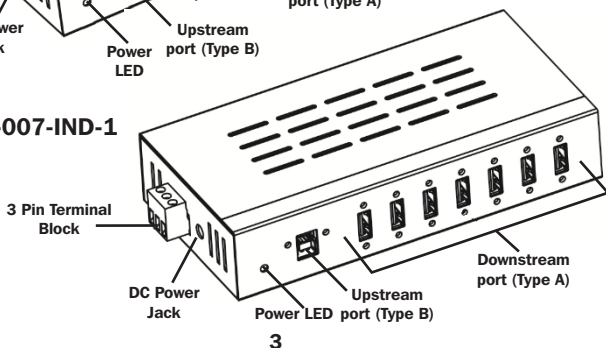

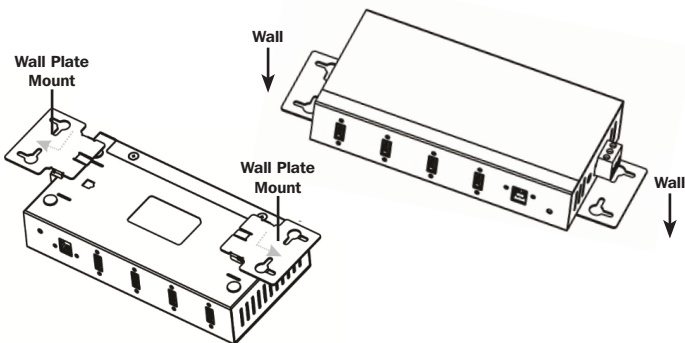

Installation

The industrial hub can be mounted on a wall, if desired. Use the included Wall Mounting Kit to mount the hub to the wall.



- 1 Connect a user-supplied power adapter to the USB Hub. The power LED should illuminate solid. Supplying power is optional; however, to ensure each USB port is fully powered, connecting external power is recommended

Note: The terminal block and DC jack power input **SHOULD NOT** be used simultaneously.

- 2 Connect the USB cable from the USB hub (Type-B port) to the host computer system.
- 3 The operating system will detect the hub immediately and install it automatically.
- 4 Once installation is complete, connected USB devices will be recognized by the hub.
